Short Presentation: Every year many foreign students come to Odense to follow our two English programs AP Degree in Marketing Management and Multimedia Designer. We see the high number of international students as a clear advantage. It gives the study environment an exciting, lively multicultural touch which benefits both our Danish and foreign students. The international aspect is integrated in all of our education programs, e.g. as internships in international companies, studies abroad and activities such as 'International week'. This way our students get used to cooperating with people with other cultural backgrounds. Costs: The cost of living is fairly high in Denmark. <u>Basic food expenses</u> for one person are DKK 1,000 - 2,000 per month. A reasonable priced <u>meal</u> typically costs approx DKK 100-150 Tickets are bought on the bus and the <u>bus fare</u> is DKK 16 or 20 depending on zones.
